(3) *Reader:* In the 8th Tone— For with the Lord there is mercy, and with Him is plenteous redemption;

And He shall redeem Israel out of all His in-iq - - - ui-ties.

Making themselves like unto the incorporeal ones, O Lord, /
 with prayer and abstinence /
 Thy saints dispelled the passions of the flesh /

(2) *Reader:* O praise the Lord, all ye nations;

Praise Him all ye peo - - - - - ples.

Taking up zeal for the virtues, /

the heresy of Arius and Nestorius, /
and as champions of the Orthodox /
have received the acclaim of all. //
Through their prayers, O Christ, grant Thy people great mercy.
