destroyed the tyrannous enemy and delivered us from his de - ceit,


thou hast led us to the King, Christ our God.

O all-blessed and most laud-ed one, be-seech Him to grant peace and health,


steadfast might and victory over the hea - then to thy peo - ple,

and great mer - cy to our souls.


